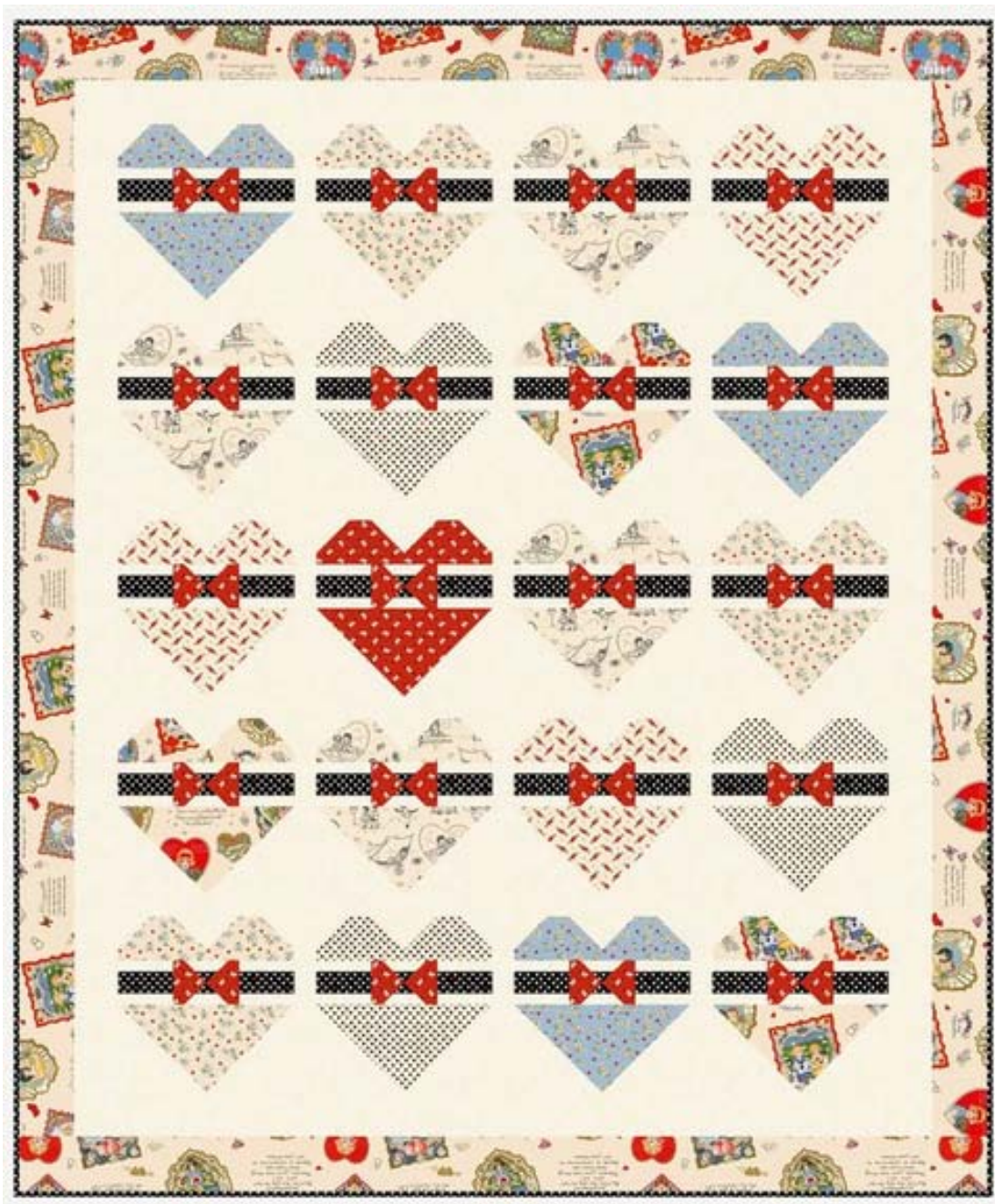




Finished quilt size: 44" x 53

Finished block size: 8" x 8"

Backing: 52" x 61" (3y of 42" wide fabric, horizontal seam)

Fabric and Cutting Chart

 <p>Fabric A R540554-Cream</p>	<p>2y</p>	<p>a. Pieced blocks (10) 1" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (4) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (80) 2" x 2" squares. (5) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.</p> <p>b. Sashing rectangles (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (15) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>c. Sashing strips (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 35 1/2" strips.</p> <p>d. Inner border (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 39 1/2" from (2) WOF strips. Piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.</p>
 <p>Fabric B R551641D Cream</p>	<p>3/4y</p>	<p>a. Pieced blocks (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (3) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>b. Outer border (5) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3" x 44 1/2" and (2) 3" x 48 1/2" strips.</p>
 <p>Fabric C R551642D Cream</p>	<p>1/4y</p>	<p>a. Pieced blocks (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.</p>

 <p>Fabric F R551644D Cream</p>	<p>3/4y, includes binding</p>	<p>a. Pieced blocks (4) 1" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing. b. Binding (6) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a binding strip.</p>
 <p>Fabric I R551645D Red</p>	<p>3/8y</p>	<p>a. Pieced blocks (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2" x 2 1/2" rectangles. (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" and (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.</p>

Constructing pieced blocks

1. Sew together (1) 1" x WOF Fabric A and (1) 1" x WOF Fabric F strips, along the long sides to make a strip set. Make a total of (4) strip sets. Subcut (80) "pieced square" units at 1 1/2" intervals.



2. Finger press (1) step 1 unit diagonally to determine the correct seam orientation. Once determined, draw the diagonal line on the wrong side of step 1 unit, crossing the two different fabrics. Place step 1 unit, right sides together, at the top right corner of (1) 2" (horizontal) x 2 1/2" (vertical) Fabric I rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another pieced square unit at the bottom right of the same Fabric I rectangle, as shown.



Repeat to make an additional unit.

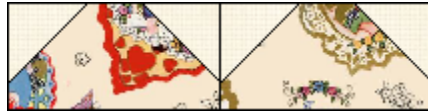
3. Sew (2) 1" x WOF Fabric A strips to the opposite long sides of (1) 1 1/2" Fabric F strip to make a strip set. Make a total of (3) strip sets. Subcut (40) units at 3" intervals.



4. Sew together (2) step 2 units. Then sew (2) step 3 units to the opposite short ends to make a row unit, as shown. Row unit measures 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished.



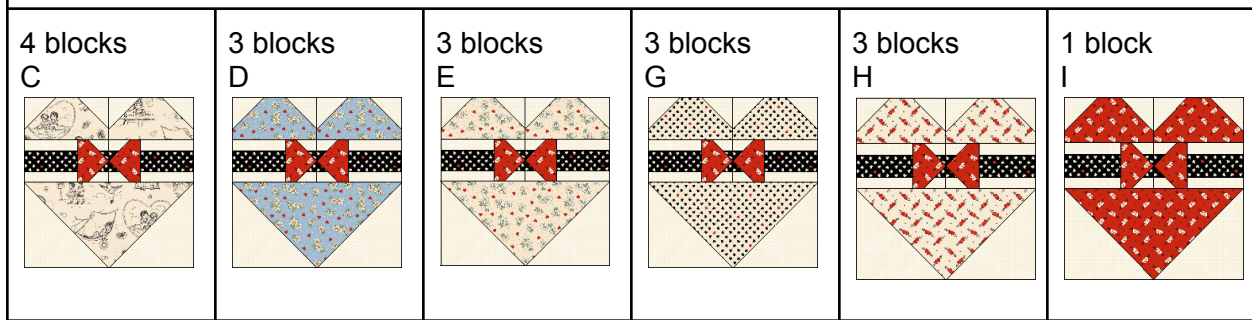
5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" x 2" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric B rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 2" x 2" Fabric A square at the top right corner of the same Fabric B rectangle. Repeat to make another unit. Sew together both units to make a row unit.



6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom left corner of (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric B rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric A square at the bottom right corner of the same Fabric B rectangle. Make a total of (3) blocks.



7. Make a total number of blocks for the following fabrics:



Quilt top assembly

Note: Border strips are sewn longer strips first to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by shorter strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (4) pieced blocks, alternating with (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (5) pieced rows.

2. Quilt center. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strips to complete quilt center.

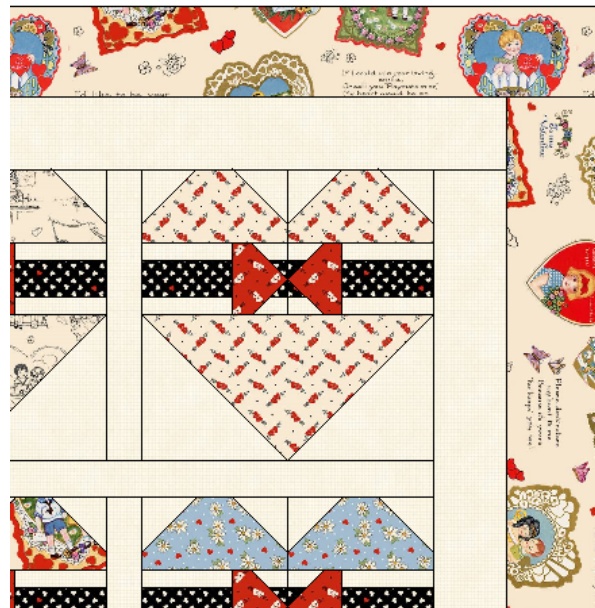


3. Inner border. Fabric A.

(2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, then (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $39\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

4. Outer border. Fabric B.

(2) 3" x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, then (2) 3" x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to complete quilt top.



Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
