

## Patchwork Watermelon Table Runner Supply List

We do have a kit to make choosing fabrics easy. If you choose not to purchase a kit you will need the following:

### Pattern

Strips or Scraps of 10 - 12 Fabrics in corals and pinks (minimum 2 ½" X 2 ½")

2" X 40" strip of red and white picnic check for sashing

Scrap of black felt or wool felt for seeds

0.6m green tonal for binding and watermelon rinds

4 – 12 ½" X 12 ½" cream fabrics for backgrounds

2m white ½" ric rac

### Supplies needed that are not included in kit:

18" X 58" Backing Fabric

18" X 58" Batting

0.65m Wonder Under

### Notions Required:

Thread – 50 weight white thread (We prefer working with Presencia)

Isacord or Mettler Polysheen thread in green (binding) and red (quilting on the watermelons)

Mary Ellen's Best Press

### Tools Required:

18" x 24" rotary cutting mat

Rotary cutter and new blade (we recommend the OMNIGRID 28 or 45mm cutter - very safe and easy to use)

Ruler - 6½" or 8½" x 24" for cutting fabric

Ruler - 8½" square - optional

Measuring tape - 120"

Sewing machine in good working order with universal and quilting needles, bobbins and manual

Foot - ¼" piecing foot (must have for first class)

Foot - walking foot (must have for third class)

Basic sewing supplies - pins, scissors, extra sewing machine needles, etc.

Please bring snacks to class, there will be a break for lunch. Coffee or water can also be brought in a sealable container.
